



## FIELD TRIP REGULATIONS

<p><b>Education Code 35330-35332</b></p>	<p>K-12 school districts are permitted to conduct field trips or excursions in connection with school-related courses and activities. The following are relevant excerpts from the Code:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• “All persons making the field trip or excursion shall be deemed to have waived all claims against the district or the State of California for injury, accident, illness, or death occurring during or by reason of the field trip or excursion. All adults taking out-of-state field trips or excursions and all parents or guardians of pupils taking out-of-state field trips or excursions shall sign a statement waiving such claims.”</li> <li>• “The governing board of any school district conducting excursions and field trips pursuant to this article shall provide, or make available, medical or hospital service, or both, for pupils of the district injured while participating in any excursion or field trip under the jurisdiction of, or sponsored or controlled by, the district or the authorities of any school of the district.”</li> </ul>
<p><b>Education Code 32040-32044</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The school district shall equip the school with a first aid kit whenever students are taken on field trips.</li> <li>• The first aid kit may include a snakebite kit whenever a field trip is conducted in areas infested by poisonous snakes.</li> </ul>
