CAMP DESCRIPTIONS



Outdoor Adventure Camp - \$185 five day, \$165 four day
June 7– 11 & June 28–July 2
For K-8th grades

This is our most popular camp so we are offering it twice this summer. This camp includes hiking, **archery, **kayaking, beach day at Whiskeytown Lake, fishing, swimming, wading, arts/crafts, field games, and exploring.
**must be in 4th grade or higher to participate in kayaking & archery



Earth Skills - \$185 five day, \$165 four day
June 21-25
For K-8th grades

This camp focuses on introductory survival skills, wilderness awareness, and nature art. Activities may include shelter building, rope making, basketry, necklace making and ceramics, as well as hiking, **archery, **kayaking, beach day at Whiskeytown Lake, fishing, swimming/wading
**must be in 4th grade or higher to participate in kayaking & archery



Theater Arts - \$185 five days only - July 19-23
For K-8th grades

This camp teaches basic theater skills, improvisation, mask making, set and costume design, storytelling, and monologues all in a beautiful outdoor setting along Clear Creek. In addition to these theater art related activities, campers will also enjoy hiking, wading in a mountain stream, pond exploration and lawn games. Overnight Backpacking Trips - \$275 five days, four nights
Lassen Volcanic Park
For ages 14-18 - Space is limited

Students will explore the backcountry of Lassen, hike between 2-8 miles daily, set up camp in a new & beautiful place every night, and rest alongside lakes & streams & wildflowers.
