Assembly Bill 2160, also known as the Ting Bill mandates that schools electronically submit grade point averages (GPAs) for **grade twelve** students to the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC). The information is utilized to determine student eligibility for Cal Grant higher education funding. Also, AB 2160 requires that the school district or charter school notify parents in writing of certain opt-out requirements by October 15 of a pupil's grade twelve academic year.
